To whom it may concern:

Be advised that on Friday morning, the fifth of February (2/5/99) the vessel Caribbean Clipper will be arriving at the port of Mobile, Alabama, containing lobster tails from Honduras. This container consigned to Seamerica, a Florida corporation contains thousands of pounds (30000) of undersized (3&4oz) lobster tails, a violation of Honduran law, packed in bags. The product will be stored at Christian Salvensen in Mobile, Alabama.

It is a violation of Honduran law, to export product in bulk, our law requires that all product exported from our country should be packed in boxes. These actions take jobs from our people, hurt our fisheries, and our economy.

We ask that you look into this matter and proceed accordingly.
